Kindergartens

According to the School Education Law (*Gakko Kyoiku Ho*), kindergartens are considered schools and are under the jurisdiction of the Ministry for Education, Science and Technology. Kindergartens are educational facilities for children aged 3 years and older which they attend in the years before they enter elementary school or compulsory education school.

They are established by the state, regional public bodies, and school foundations.

In Nishinomiya City, there are municipal and private kindergartens. Generally, parents can choose how many years their children will commute to kindergarten, from 1-3 years.

Nishinomiya Municipal Kindergartens are 2-year kindergartens.
